

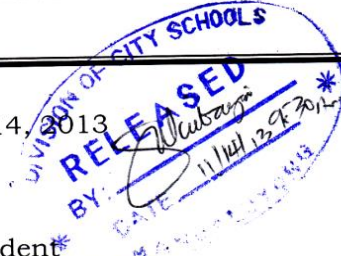

The policy of no disruption of classes should be strictly observed.



The Dangerous Drugs Board, through its Policy Studies Research and Statistics Division is currently undertaking an assessment of the Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD) Program being implemented in public secondary schools in the country. The present study will be initiated in the National Capital Region (NCR). Findings of the study will provide the Board basis for the formulation of policies and measures inclined to better address the prevention, education and control aspects of drug abuse in the said target groups.

In 2010, the DDB, in coordination with the Health and Nutrition Center of the Department of Education (HNC-DepEd), conducted a series of BKD seminars and life skills training. It targeted regional and division superintendents/supervisors and NDEP coordinators who were trained as BKD coordinators in the schools under their supervisions.

In this connection, may we request your assistance by providing the DDB Research Team an endorsement to conduct interviews with the regional and division superintendents/supervisors who participated in the BKD seminars, including school principals and some students in the randomly selected public secondary schools.
