Subject: INVITATIONAL SOUTHERN LUZON REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBORETTE 2014


1. The Southern Luzon Regional Scout Committees (NCR, STR, & BR) are pleased to announce the conduct of the Invitational Southern Luzon Regional Scout Jamborette 2014 to be held at the Philippine Scouting Center for the Asia-Pacific Region, Makiling National Scout Reservation (PSC-APR, MNSR), Mt. Makiling, Los Banos, Laguna on January 23 – 28, 2014.
2. Challenging and relevant activities will revolve around the theme: "Scouting: Advocate of Sustainable Environment".
3. The Jamborette aims to:
 - 3.1. Empower the Scouts to struggle against Climate Change from its threatening massive destruction of planet earth.
 - 3.2. Harness the Scouts' incredible human potentials to formulate and implement effective strategies to support the global effort for sustainable environment.
 - 3.3. Rally the Scouts to become effective agents of change to save Mother Earth.
 - 3.4. Plan and implement a dynamic program of challenging and relevant activities to educate the young people.
4. Invited to participate are Boy Scouts Senior Scouts and Rover Scouts and experienced Unit Leaders who are graduates of at least the Basic Training Course.
5. A Jamborette Activity Fee of Six Hundred Fifty pesos (PhP650.00) shall be charged each participant (Scout & Unit Leader) to defray the expenses for Administration and Program budgetary requirements such as: Camp Fee, Camp Development, Personnel services, Awards, printed activity T-Shirt, ID, Certificate, Program materials and other incidental

Administration and Program expenditures.

6. Council Contingents are required to be responsible for their respective round trip transportation requirements, adequate camping supplies and materials such as: portable shelters for group and individuals, camp tools and equipment, sufficient food supply, etc.
7. Conformably with established national camping policies, Local Councils are required to submit to the Regional Office the roster of duly organized contingent together with the medical certificates, parental authority and duly accomplished application to attend the Jamborette, and the corresponding individual reservation fee of Four Hundred pesos (PhP400.00), which is non-refundable but transferable, not later than Friday, November 15, 2013. The remaining balance of Two Hundred Fifty pesos (PhP250.00) must be paid upon arrival at the Jamborette venue.
8. The host region must be supplied with the updated advisory from the participating Councils concerning their mode of transportation, estimated time of arrival and departure, and other requirements at least two (2) weeks in advance in order to prepare every need in due time.
9. For widest publicity, information, guidance and compliance of all concerned.
